Dear DCSS Parent/Guardian,

Dayton Christian School System is blessed with having a clinic on each campus that is staffed with a nurse on the Xenia campus and a nurse and clinic aide on the Dayton campus. The clinic is designed for first aid, dispensing of medications and short-term assistance until the student can either return to class or be sent home. In order to provide for the well-being and safety of all our students and in accordance with the Ohio Department of Health Requirements, we ask that you observe and comply with the following:

Immunizations/Physicals

*All students are required to provide a record of all Ohio Department of Health required immunizations or an exemption form on file. The student may be withheld from attending if one is not provided by the 15th day of school.

*All preschoolers are required to have on file documentation of a physical examination completed within the last year. This is true for each year they attend preschool.

Medications

*Students may not carry any medications on their person, in their locker or personal effects. The only exception is emergency medication needed for asthma, allergies or diabetes and then only with notification to the clinic and the appropriate form completed by parent and physician.

*Over-the-counter medications, (e.g. Tylenol, Benedryl) need to be kept in the clinic and brought in the original container along with the non-prescription form completed and signed by parent or guardian.

*Prescription medications that need to be dispensed during school need to be brought to the clinic along with the prescription form completed and signed by the physician and the parent.

*Medications containing narcotics will **not** be dispensed or kept in the clinic.

*Medications will be dispensed by a nurse, clinic aide, or designated Dayton Christian employee trained in medication administration.

Illnesses Requiring Exclusion from School

Chicken Pox-----Excluded from school until all lesions are crusted over.

Conjunctivitis----- (Pink Eye) -Excluded from school, may return 24 hours after medication has begun.

Diarrheal Diseases----Excluded from school until diarrhea free for 24 hours.

Fifth Disease-----Student may return as physician directs or when fever has subsided.

Head Lice -----Excluded from school until treated and head inspection by clinic staff reveals no lice and very few to no nits. Parents are to notify nurse if their child has lice.

Influenza-----Excluded from school until fever-free for 24 hours.

Impetigo-----May return 24 hours after treatment has begun and no drainage present.

Measles-----Excluded from school until a physician's note is turned in which designates a return date.

Mononucleosis-----Student may return as physician directs.

Rashes-----Student may be sent home and not allowed to return without physician's note.

Ringworm-----Excluded from school until treatment has begun.

Scabies-----Excluded from school until student and household contacts have been treated, and written permission from physician.

Strep Throat-----May return to school 24 hours after medication has begun if no fever is present.

MRSA-----May return to school with written permission from the physician. All affected areas must be covered.

Fevers..... Greater than or equal to 100 degrees.

Emergency Medical Authorization Form

All students are required to have an Emergency Medical Authorization Form on file by the 15th day of school or the student may be withheld from attending until one is provided. If your child is temporarily under someone else's care or there are any changes such as phone numbers, emergency contacts or new allergies you need to notify the secretary or clinic in writing.

Vision and Hearing Screening

Every new student will be screened for a vision or hearing problem by a nurse, audiologist or a trained volunteer at the school during school hours. In addition, your student will be screened in Preschool, Kindergarten, and grades 1,3,5,7 and 9. This is a screening only and not an in-depth exam.

Special Passes

*Pokey pass, elevator pass, gym excuse-please see the clinic for any of these. A physician's note may be required for passes requiring extended amounts of time.
