Dear Families,

In Deuteronomy 6, we read that God places the responsibility for Christian education with the parents. Dayton Christian School System (DCSS) realizes that there are families **committed to Christian education** who do not have the financial resources to pay the full tuition cost. In keeping with one of our foundational convictions, DCSS has established a tuition assistance program to help families who:

- a. **Have sacrificed in their daily living to make Christian education a priority,**
- b. Have a commitment to become debt-free,
- c. Have committed to establishing and living on a balanced budget, and
- d. Are active in the body of Christ (local church). Involvement in the local church (Hebrews 10:24-25) is an outward demonstration of the value a family places on a God-centered education for their family.

Accordingly, family commitment to Christian education will be evaluated in the following three areas:

1. Parent's commitment to continued spiritual growth for themselves and their children, evidenced by both the parent's and the student's support of the mission of DCSS.
2. Student commitment to Christian education as evidenced by giving their best effort in **academics, spiritual matters and behavior, which will be evaluated each year by their principal.**
3. Family involvement and participation in the local church **with confirmation by the pastor** (Church Evaluation Form).

The level of tuition assistance a family may receive will be based on items 1-3 above and the following criteria:

- a. Household annual adjusted gross income (AGI)
- b. Number of students from your household attending DCSS and total number of dependents
- c. Financial hardship situations and any other extenuating circumstances
- d. The school's ability to meet your need without exceeding its tuition assistance budget for the year.

**NOTE:** It is expected that the family will take the initiative to **immediately contact the Admissions Office** should your finances change in any way.

All information will be treated as confidential and shared only with the Tuition Assistance Committee as they have considered your request. Please feel free to contact the Admissions Office at (937) 291-7212 if you have any questions.
