I am pleased to announce that two significant improvements are forthcoming. First, a new online process will enhance your ability to re-register returning students. In addition, our new notification system will greatly improve communications for major school announcements. The following describes the two areas of focus.

Online Re-registration:

A portion of our new overall school improvement strategy is increased customer service. As an integral part of that customer service, our current student re-registration will be an **online-based format for the 2011/2012** school year. This new online format will improve efficiency, accuracy and will greatly **simplify the process** for our parents. The online re-registration will begin in early February. The exact implementation date and details will be announced soon. I am resolved to effectively manage our finances and budgetary practices. Therefore all **current students must be re-registered by May 31st** or they will need to enroll as a new student. This change will greatly improve our financial planning, teacher hiring and student class placement efforts. An early re-registration incentive will again be offered.

One Call Phone notification system:

Therefore, we will be using an **automated notification phone service**. The system will deliver vital information within minutes of the school releasing such news. I expect to have this strategic communications method operational within the next few days.

Please look for more information relative to these exciting enhancements. I am absolutely committed to the pursuit of excellence in every aspect of the school system. It is essential that our children have a school where they are nurtured, trained and encouraged by godly educators to learn to “think and act like Jesus.” Like you, I truly desire that our children and families have the best school in the region.
