Week 1 Class Offerings

Grades 1-4

Session 1:

Outdoor Wonder - Campers will learn about plants, wildlife, and ecosystems while fostering a love for the outdoors.

PE - A high-energy class where campers will engage in fun games, team challenges and fitness activities.

Session 2:

Sew What? Let's Create! - Beginner-friendly sewing class where campers learn stitching basics and create fun projects—from simple crafts to personalized designs.

Brush It Up! Art Fun for Kids - Campers will explore painting, drawing, and crafts that spark imagination and self-expression.

Session 3:

Choose Your Own Adventure - Campers will create amazing characters, dream up exciting plots, and write stories where every choice leads to a new twist.

Survival of the Fittest – Campers will build confidence by tackling fun obstacle courses and engaging in physical challenges that include climbing walls and balance beams.

Session 4:

Nature Lab – Campers will explore ecosystems, conduct nature experiments, and uncover connections between plants, animals, and the environment.

Art Odyssey – Campers will explore painting, drawing, sculpture, and mixed media. Each day will inspire creativity and result in unique masterpieces.

Grades 1-4

Session 1:

PE - Campers will stay active, build teamwork skills, and have a blast with sports and creative physical challenges

Zoology- This hands-on class brings science to life for animal lovers in a safe, educational setting, including birds and therapy mini horses.

Session 2:

STEM- Campers will tackle exciting experiments, engineering challenges, and problem-solving activities that make learning fun and interactive.

Session 3:
